

IRATA Level 1 - Rope Access Technician



Course Aim

To provide delegates with knowledge and understanding of the roles and responsibilities of work at height using rope access.

Successful delegates receive an internationally recognised qualification in Industrial Rope Access, allowing you to work on a wide variety of structures in all types of industry sectors - from window cleaning on skyscrapers, to cliff stabilisation, or Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) on offshore installations.



Who Should Attend?

Those who require the knowledge and skills on the safe use of equipment, basic legislation and on a wide range of rope access manoeuvres (including simple rescue).



Course Duration

This is a 5-day course.



Maximum Delegates

The maximum number of delegates is 2.



Certification

Successful delegates will receive an IRATA Level 1 Industrial Rope Access certificate which is valid for 3 years.
