

IPAF MEWP Spotter (e-Learning)

Course Aim

Online e-learning course focused on the important role of assisting MEWP operators when visibility is limited on site.

This course aims to help delegates:

- Understand the responsibilities of a MEWP Spotter and how they contribute to overall site safety
- Recognise hazards and obstacles that may be outside the MEWP operator's line of sight
- Communicate effectively with operators using standard industry hand signals
- Work as part of a team with MEWP operators to ensure safe manoeuvring of equipment

Who Should Attend?

Anyone who may need to assist a MEWP Operator in safely manoeuvring a MEWP on site, particularly when visibility is restricted.

The course is aimed at:

- Delegates acting as MEWP Spotters on construction or industrial sites
- MEWP Operators who want to understand how to work effectively with a Spotter
- Anyone involved in planning or coordinating tasks where MEWP movement could pose risks

The IPAF MEWP Spotter course is theory-based and delivered via eLearning. By the end of the course, delegates will have explored the key practices to perform the MEWP Spotter role confidently and safely.

The course covers:

- Key responsibilities of a MEWP Spotter
- How and where to position yourself safely on site, including managing exclusion zones
- Industry-recognised hand signals and voice instructions to guide Operators safely where there is restricted visibility
- Safe practices for MEWP operations
- Common hazards and ways to minimise risks
